Authorization To Assist Sauk Village Emergency Management And Homeland Security Agency

I, Amon Darnell, authorize U.S. Investigation and Protection Agency and the U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau to assist in all emergencies and natural disasters. All Emergency responders must be on call 24 hours per day to be available to assist in emergency and natural disaster crisis. All emergency responders will have proper emergency lighting to include Red, Blue, White and Yellow emergency lights, reflective clothing and necessary equipment to assist in emergencies.

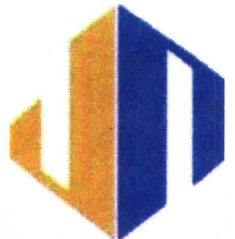
Also, it is understood that those emergency responders from U.S. Investigation and Protection Agency and U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau will maintain their equipment necessary for personal defense, including but not limited pepper spray, baton, handcuffs, PepperBall Launchers and firearms. Only that equipment that the agent is qualified to carry will be utilized.

All emergency responders will report to Amon Darnell, Deputy Coordinator for the Sauk Village Emergency Management Agency.



AUTHORIZATION TO ARREST AND ASSIST

In a collaborative effort with U.S. Investigations and Protection Agency and U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau to decrease the number of active warrants and assist the Village of University Park, Illinois Police Department, I, John Pate Chief of Police of University Park, Illinois, do hereby authorize and empower U.S. Investigations and Protection Agency and U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau and its Agents to lawfully operate as The Departments Fugitive Warrants Task Force. The Fugitive Task Force agents will also be required to be on call 24 hours a day with unrestricted authorization to carry firearms (revolver, semi-automatic, rifle and shotgun), blue, white, red, and amber emergency vehicle lighting and other equipment required to respond to emergencies and requests for departmental assistance.

U.S. Investigations and Protection Agency / U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau shall also serve as a training unit for the University Park Police Department providing firearms training, non-lethal and less than lethal training, compliance training, etc. Agency directors and Training Agents of U.S. Investigations and Protection Agency and U.S. Fugitive Enforcement Bureau will report directly to the Chief of Police.
